Towers

This defensive complex is organized around the de los Pozos, de la Coracha, and de los Aljibes Towers.



Cistern

Strategic water cistern for supplying the Muslim fortress in the case of siege.



Staircase

It connected the area within the walls with the cistern, from which the water was extracted.

TOURIST CENTER

The set of towers and wells from which this defensive complex derives its name was built by the Almohads in the 12th century and has undergone subsequent reforms.



Coracha

Water tower that would have been connected to the defensive framework of the Almohad Alcázar.



Garden

Courtyard of this rehabilitated defensive complex for the celebration of cultural activities and shows.



Home

Located in the Old Jewish Quarter, it has been repurposed as a tourist centre.
