Let yourself get lost among the World Heritage sites

The Arco de la Estrella, with its peculiar curved arches, the Toledo-Moctezuma Palace, symbol of a Latin American crossover, of which Cáceres was a protagonist in the 16th century, the Co-Cathedral of Santa María, the Episcopal Palace, the Carvajal Palace, and endless other monuments will not leave you unmoved.



To the highest point

In the Plaza de San Jorge, the whiteness of the two towers of the church of San Francisco Javier stand out, as well as the sobriety of the school of the Society of Jesus. It is a joint space between the lower neighbourhood and the upper neighbourhood, crowned by the church of San Mateo and the tower of the Palacio de las Cigüeñas--an authentic watchtower that Isabella the Catholic allowed to be built higher than any other building.



Among the labyrinth of narrow streets

The twists and turns that let you appreciate the imposing parapets of the Torre de Sande and the Casa del Sol help us to understand the wars between nobles that gave meaning to the fortified architecture of Cáceres. The tour returns us to the Plaza Mayor, walking through Adarves, after you have felt and lived through Cáceres in an unforgettable monumental experience.
