International Distinction

Holy Week in Cáceres was declared of International Tourist Interest in 2011. It is an outstanding distinction granted, above all, for the artistic value of its sculptured floats, the solemnity and devotion of its processions, and for the impressive framework through which they traverse the Monumental Complex, declared a World Heritage Site in 1986.
