### **La Casa Grande**

Built on Pizarro Street in 1910, it houses an extraordinary museum of contemporary art: the Visual Arts Centre, Helga de Alvear Foundation.



### **La Casa de las Chicuelas**

Throughout the twentieth century, some relevant works were lost due to urban development pressure, which did not take the great architectural value of these buildings into account. However, they were rebuilt later.



### **The palace of San Antón**

The municipal architect, Ángel Pérez Rodríguez, was the great innovator in the realm of 20th century local architecture
