The first WOMAD was promoted by Peter Gabriel in Reading (England) in 1982 to promote multiculturalism, tolerance, and coexistence. Since then, it has been held in more than 30 countries. WOMAD has been established in Spain for some time with the Cáceres festival, which celebrated its 25th anniversary in 2016.
